Headway Ipswich and East Suffolk has been named as a semi-finalist in a national awards scheme – and now the Group needs your help to get through to the final!

The National Lottery Awards are an annual search to find the UK's favourite Lottery-funded projects. Headway Ipswich's therapists project is competing with nine other schemes in the Best Health Project category for a cash prize of £2,000 and a trophy that will be presented live on BBC1's *The One Show*.

The Headway project comprises a team of four therapists who provide speech and language therapy, physiotherapy, occupational therapy and counselling for people who have sustained a brain injury, while also supporting their family carers.
